Project Limits

Yaeger Road and Milburn Road Intersection

Project Summary and Scope

Project AR-1860 will turn the 4-way stop controlled intersection into a one-lane roundabout. The scope of work includes providing ADA-compliant curb ramps and sidewalks, including a sidewalk extension on the northeast quadrant that will connect Yaeger Circle Drive to Milburn Road.

What's the problem?

Yaeger-Milburn intersection crash rate is among the top 10 highest on St. Louis County system (48 crashes between 2017 and 2020, 10 with injuries). A roundabout is a proven safety countermeasure, shown to reduce crashes by 40%. Roundabouts improve congestion and reduce delays at intersections. They also reduce fuel consumption and auto emissions.
